# Cleaning & maintenance tips

**Machine wash:** bassinet fabric, seat fabric, sun canopy, mattress cover.

**Do not wash, clean with damp cloth:** mattress foam, underseat basket, grips, rain cover.

## IMPORTANT:

- Always check the fabric label before washing.
- Before washing, remove panels and stiffeners from fabrics where applicable.

## When washing, don't forget:

- maximum temperature 30°C/85°F (cold wash)
- do not use bleach or aggressive detergents
- do not tumble dry
- do not iron
- do not dry clean
- always wash separately

Routinely inspect and maintain your stroller.

**Chassis:** Clean the chassis with a soft towel and lukewarm water and wipe off any remaining water with a dry cloth. Use a soft brush to clean sand and dirt from the mechanisms and sliding tubes of the chassis. Take care to brush away from any sliding joints.

**Wheels:** Use a brush and water to clean dirt on the wheels. Periodically, remove the wheels from the chassis and brush off any dirt or sand in the inside axle of the wheel.

**After washing:** Always re-assemble the (dry) parts back into original state as instructed in the user guide.

**Wet conditions:** Store your Bugaboo stroller and its accessories in a dry place and leave them to dry unfolded to prevent mold.

- Your Bugaboo stroller is not resistant to salt water.
- Avoid contact between adhesive straps and the fabrics of your stroller. This may damage the fabrics.
- On floors such as synthetic laminates, parquet, linoleum and carpet (organic surface floors), rubber black tires may leave permanent marks. Should you have a floor as mentioned above we recommend to be careful with indoor usage.

#### **CHILDREN AND YOUR STROLLER**

1. Do not let your child play with this product.
2. To avoid injury ensure that the child is kept away when (un)folding and when making adjustments to this product.
3. Do not let other children play unattended near the bassinet.
4. Keep children and appendages away from the adapter interface when attaching the car seat.
5. Avoid injury from stored energy – Do not let your child(ren) play with the leg rest.
6. The vehicle is not to be used as an unsupervised sleeping environment.

#### **BEFORE USE**

7. The carry handle(s)/bumper bar and the bottom of the bassinet should be inspected regularly for signs of damage and wear.



8. Check that the bassinet or seat unit or car seat attachment devices are correctly engaged before use.
9. Ensure that all the locking devices are engaged before use and always apply the brake when loading or unloading your child.
10. Before carrying or lifting the bassinet make sure that the carry handle is in correct position of use.
11. Before each use ensure that the harness is working properly and the handlebar is locked.
12. FALL HAZARD - Always check that the bassinet is securely locked on the base/stand by pulling upwards on the bassinet bed.
13. Brakes must always be applied when the pram/stroller is not moving.
14. Adjust the length of the handle according to the indication symbols on the handlebar and the schematic diagram of the instruction manual. The shortest length of the handlebar is not the use position which is for locking the folded chassis.
15. Always make sure the bassinet is empty before folding. Remove the infant from the bassinet or the seat before folding the stroller.

## **USAGE RESTRICTIONS**

### **Product in general**

16. The Bugaboo Donkey 6 is suitable for children from 0 to 48 months (22 kg).
  - Maximum weight for the underseat bag is 15kg and 70l.
  - Maximum weight for the side bag on the chassis is 10 kg.
  - Maximum weight for the side bag on the handlebar is 4 kg.
17. Use only manufacturer recommended weights in the under seat basket otherwise the stroller may become unstable.
18. Unstable hazardous conditions may exist if any of the recommended load by Bugaboo is exceeded and if package carrying accessories are added onto the product.
19. Do not use more than one accessory, included the bag provided in the box, on the handlebar of Bugaboo Donkey 6 .
20. Do not place more than one approved accessory on the handlebar of your stroller. Risk of stroller tipping over.
21. Exceeding any of the recommended loads may affect the stability of the stroller. Any load attached to the handle and/or on the back of the backrest and/or on the sides of the stroller will also affect its stability.
22. Take your child out of the Bugaboo stroller when going up or down stairs and around steep or unstable conditions. Also, take extra care when going up or down a curb or other uneven surfaces. Do not take your stroller on the escalator.
23. The Bugaboo Donkey 6 is designed for two children. An additional child may ride along on the optional Bugaboo wheeled board, according to the usage instructions.
24. Do not allow children heavier than 20 kg to stand on the Bugaboo wheeled board.
25. Ensure that the comfort wheeled board is correctly engaged before use.
26. Never pick up the Bugaboo stroller and chassis by the carry handle(s)/ bumper bar while your child is lying or sitting in the bassinet or seat on the



chassis.

27. FALL HAZARD - Do not carry child in side luggage basket. Use bassinet or seat only.
28. Always use the canopy in the fully reclined position.
29. The canopy provides a critical containment function for infants and small children. Ensure that it is firmly attached.
30. The Bugaboo Donkey 6 frame (no. 100430001) should only be used with the Bugaboo Donkey 6 chassis (no. 100431001). Do not use Bugaboo Donkey 6 parts or components with any non-approved stroller or any other Bugaboo product.
31. Only use authentic Bugaboo replacement parts and Bugaboo accessories or products approved by Bugaboo for use with the Bugaboo stroller. It is unsafe to use products that are not approved by Bugaboo.
32. Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a bassinet or cradle or attach strings to toys.
- 33. There is potential for fingers or parts of the body to be injured when the vehicle is being folded or unfolded, and due care should be exercised.**
34. Do not use the Bugaboo stroller or any of its components near open flames or other sources of heat. Avoid exposing the Bugaboo stroller to extreme temperatures.
35. The Bugaboo stroller is not resistant to salt water.
36. It is possible that on floors such as synthetic laminates, parquet, linoleum and carpet (organic surface floors), rubber black tires may leave permanent marks. Should you have a floor as mentioned above we recommend to be careful with indoor usage.
37. This product is not suitable for running or skating.
38. WARNING: Use the wrist loop strap to stop the pram/stroller rolling away.
39. Ensure vehicle is correctly folded and latch engaged when lifting or carrying the vehicle.
40. The vehicle is designed for use on flat or gently sloping surfaces. It may be unstable on higher sloping and uneven surfaces; users should be made aware of the possibility of the vehicle tipping over.

### **BASSINET SPECIFIC**

41. Maximum weight for the child in the bassinet is 9 kg.
42. This product is only suitable for a child who cannot sit up unaided.
43. FALL HAZARD -To help prevent falls, do not use this product when the infant begins to push up on hands and knees or has reached 9 kg, whichever comes first.
44. Do not use the bassinet or a car seat in the two wheel position.
45. SUFFOCATION HAZARD Infants have suffocated:
  - In gaps between extra padding and the side of the bassinet/cradle, and
  - On soft bedding. Use ONLY the mattress, including sheet cover and aerated inlay, provided by Bugaboo for the Bugaboo stroller.
  - NEVER add a pillow, comforter, or another mattress for padding.



## SEAT SPECIFIC

46. The seat is not suitable for children under 6 months.
47. FALL HAZARD - Avoid serious injury from falling or sliding out. Always use the complete five point restraint system.
48. Never let your child stand up in the seat. Be careful because your child may stand up even when the seatbelt is fastened.
49. Always use the wrist strap when in two wheel position.
50. WARNING: Do not use the seat facing world in the 2-wheel position. It is not an intended use position.
51. Never leave the harness buckled when not fitted to a child in the pram/stroller because the harness can form loops which may pose a strangulation.
52. Always use the canopy in the fully reclined position.
53. The canopy provides a critical containment function for infants and small children. Ensure that it is firmly attached.

## USING BASSINET OR SEAT OFF THE CHASSIS

54. Maximum weight for the child in the seat when used independently of the chassis is 9 kg.
55. Do not use for unsupervised sleeping.
56. The seat does not replace a cot or bed. The seat is not intended for prolonged periods of sleeping. Should your child need to sleep then place it in a suitable cot or bed.
57. FALL HAZARD - Child's activity can move carrier. NEVER place carrier on counter tops, tables, or any other elevated surface.
58. SUFFOCATION HAZARD - Infant carrier can roll over on soft surfaces and suffocate child. NEVER place carrier on beds, sofas, or other soft surfaces. Only use on a firm, horizontal level and dry surface.
59. NEVER use this carrier as a means to transport an infant in a motor vehicle.

60. WARNING: Do not use the Bugaboo stroller if any part is broken, torn or missing. You should ensure that any damaged or worn parts are repaired immediately.
