IMPORTANT: Always check the fabric label before washing.

When washing, don't forget:

- maximum temperature 30°C/85°F (cold wash)
- do not use bleach or aggressive detergents
- do not tumble dry
- do not iron
- do not dry clean
- always wash separately

Routinely inspect and maintain your stroller.

Chassis: Clean the chassis with a soft towel and lukewarm water and wipe off any remaining water with a dry cloth. Use a soft brush to clean sand and dirt from the mechanisms and sliding tubes of the chassis. Take care to brush away from any sliding joints.

Wheels: Use a brush and water to clean dirt on the wheels. Periodically, remove the wheels from the chassis and brush off any dirt or sand in the inside axle of the wheel.

After washing: Always re-assemble the (dry) parts back into original state as instructed in the user guide.

Wet conditions: Store your Bugaboo stroller and its accessories in a dry place and leave them to dry unfolded to prevent mold.

- Your Bugaboo stroller is not resistant to salt water.
- Avoid contact between adhesive straps and the fabrics of your stroller. This may damage the fabrics.
- On floors such as synthetic laminates, parquet, linoleum and carpet (organic surface floors), rubber black tires may leave permanent marks. Should you have a floor as mentioned above we recommend to be careful with indoor usage.

As the manufacturer, Bugaboo International BV, which has its principal place of business in Amsterdam ("Bugaboo"), supplies the Bugaboo stroller ("product") under warranty, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Bugaboo's warranty period is 24 months, from the date of purchase as indicated on the sales receipt. The remaining warranty period for the original product will apply for a replacement part or product or a repaired product.
- 2. Bugaboo's warranty applies only in the region (USA and Canada or Europe or Russia or Australia and New Zealand or Asia) in which the product was purchased. Bugaboo warrants that the product will be in compliance only with the statutory provisions and/or government regulations that apply in the region in which the product was sold. Bugaboo reserves the right to apply a different warranty for other regions.
- 3. Bugaboo's warranty provides a right to repair unless Bugaboo is of the opinion that replacement or return of the product is necessary. Bugaboo will bear the expense and risk of transport from and to the retailer ("the retailer") where you purchased the product, if the repair is covered by manufacturer's warranty.
- 4. To claim under Bugaboo's warranty you must provide Bugaboo with the following:
- a copy of the dated purchase receipt,
- · a clear description of the complaint and
- the defective product and/or photographs of the defective part or product.
- 5. Bugaboo's warranty is not transferable and may therefore only be invoked by the first owner.
- 6. Bugaboo's warranty does not affect any statutory rights you may have, for example the right to hold the retailer accountable for defects.

WHAT IS COVERED BY THE BUGABOO'S WARRANTY?

Bugaboo's warranty applies in respect of the product and covers the following:

- all manufacturing defects in the chassis, frame and the wheels;
- all manufacturing defects in the adapters (frame and car seat adapters):
- zippers
- all parts of the harness of the product:
- seams in the covering;
- self-adhesive straps.

BUGABOO'S WARRANTY WILL BE VOID IN THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:

- If you have made or arranged for modifications or repairs to be made without first having received written permission from Bugaboo or the retailer.
- Defects resulting from neglect or an accident and/or from any use or maintenance other than that indicated in the user guide.
- If the serial number has been damaged or removed.
- Damage to the product caused by normal wear and tear.
- Incorrect mounting or installation of third-party parts that are incompatible with the product.
- Inadvertent or unintentional damage, abnormal use or insufficient care.
- Improper storage / product care.
- Damage to push bars or upholstery due to normal daily use of the product.
- Holes or tears in the tires.
- Damage due to improper use or due to failure to follow user guide.
- Damage due to repairs carried out by unauthorized persons or due to improper disassembly of the product.

CHILDREN AND YOUR STROLLER

- 1. Do not let your child play with this product.
- 2. To avoid injury ensure that the child is kept away when (un)folding and when making adjustments to this product.
- 3. Do not let other children play unattended near the bassinet.
- 4. Keep children and appendages away from the adapter interface when attaching the car seat.
- 5. Avoid injury from stored energy Do not let your child(ren) play with the leg rest.

BEFORE USE

- 6. The carry handle(s)/bumper bar and the bottom of the bassinet should be inspected regularly for signs of damage and wear.
- 7. Check that the bassinet or seat unit or car seat attachment devices are correctly engaged before use.
- 8. Ensure that all the locking devices are engaged before use and always apply the brake when loading or unloading your child.
- 9. Before carrying or lifting the bassinet make sure that the carry handle is in correct position of use.
- 10. Before each use ensure that the harness is working properly and the handlebar is locked.
- 11. FALL HAZARD Always check that the bassinet is securely locked on the base/stand by pulling upwards on the bassinet bed.
- 12. Brakes must always be applied when the pram/stroller is not moving.

USAGE RESTRICTIONS

Product in general

- 13. The Bugaboo Cameleon³ is suitable for children from 0 to 48 months (17 kg/37.5 lbs).
 - Maximum weight for the under seat basket is 4 kg (8.8 lbs).
- 14. The Bugaboo Cameleon³ is suitable for children up to a height of 102 cm (40 in).
- 15. The Bugaboo Bee⁶ is suitable for children from 0 to 48 months.
 - The Bugaboo Bee⁶ seat unit is suitable for children from 0 to 48 months. Use the most reclined position of the seat for new born babies.

- FALL FAZARD Always attach the sun canopy when adjusting seat backrest to be fully reclined.
- Maximum allowed weight for the child in the seat when installed facing world is 22 kg (48.5 lbs).
- Maximum allowed weight for the child in the seat when installed facing parent is 15 kg (33 lbs).
- Maximum weight for the under seat basket is 4 kg (8.8 lbs).
- 16. The Bugaboo Bee⁶ is suitable for children up to a height of 102 cm (40 in).
- 17. The Bugaboo Donkey³ is suitable for children from 0 to 48 months (23 kg/50 lbs).
 - Maximum weight for the underseat bag is 10 kg (22 lbs) or 35 l.
 - Maximum weight for the side luggage basket is 10 kg (22 lbs).
- 18. The Bugaboo Donkey³ is suitable for children up to a height of 102 cm (40 in).
- 19. The Bugáboo Fox² is suitable for children from 0 to 48 months (23 kg/50 lbs).
 - Maximum weight for the underseat bag is 10 kg (22 lbs) or 35 l.
 - Stability hazard: Lock the front swivel wheels when children heavier than 15 kg (33 lbs) are seated in seat unit facing parents.
- 20. The Bugaboo Fox² is suitable for children up to a height of 102 cm (40 in).
- 21. The Bugaboo Ant is suitable for children from 0 to 48 months.
 - The Bugaboo Ant seat unit is suitable for children from 0 to 48 months. Use the most reclined position of the seat for new born babies.
 - Maximum allowed weight for the child in the seat 22 kg (48.5 lbs).
 - Maximum weight for the under seat basket is 3 kg (6.6 lbs).
 - Maximum weight for the rear compartment of underseat basket is 5 kg (11 lbs).
 - After unfolding, always ensure the stroller is locked before use.
 - Do not use any other hardware accessories when using the the stroller in combination with the Comfort Wheeled Board. Risk of stroller tipping over.
 - · Side panels must be attached correctly before use.
 - WARNING: ENTRAPMENT HAZARD Never use the stroller with the top handlebar folded.

- 23. The Bugaboo Lynx is suitable for children up to a height of 102 cm (40 in).
- 24. Use only manufacturer recommended weights in the under seat basket otherwise the stroller may become unstable.
- 25. Unstable hazardous conditions may exist if any of the recommended load by Bugaboo is exceeded and if package carrying accessories are added onto the product.
- 26. Take your child out of the Bugaboo stroller when going up or down stairs and around steep or unstable conditions. Also, take extra care when going up or down a curb or other uneven surfaces. Do not take your stroller on the escalator.
- 27. The Bugaboo Cameleon³, the Bugaboo Bee⁶, the Bugaboo Fox², the Bugaboo Ant and Bugaboo Lynx are designed for one child only. An additional child may ride along on the optional Bugaboo wheeled board, according to the usage instructions.
- 28. The Bugaboo Donkey³ is designed to carry up to two children in the duo position and a third child on the wheeled board, according to the usage instructions.
- 29. Do not allow children heavier than 20 kg (44 lbs) to stand on the Bugaboo wheeled board.
- 30. Ensure that the comfort wheeled board is correctly engaged before use.
- 31. Never pick up the Bugaboo stroller and chassis by the carry handle(s)/bumper bar while your child is lying or sitting in the bassinet or seat on the chassis.
- 32. FALL HAZARD Do not carry child in side luggage basket. Use bassinet or seat only.
- 33. The Bugaboo Cameleon³ frame (no. 230203 or 230203ZW01) should only be used with the Bugaboo Cameleon³ chassis (no. 234300 or 234320). Do not use Bugaboo Cameleon³ parts or components with any non-approved stroller or any other Bugaboo product.
- 34. The Bugaboo Bee⁶ seat unit (no. 504308) and Bugaboo Bee⁶ bassinet (no. 500233XX01) should only be used with the Bugaboo Bee⁶ chassis (no. 504307AL01 or 504307ZW01). Do not use Bugaboo Bee⁶ parts or components with any non-approved pushchair, other device or any other Bugaboo product.
- 35. The Bugaboo Donkey³ frame (no.181203 or 181202ZW02) should only be used with the Bugaboo Donkey³ chassis (no. 184253AL02 or 184253ZW02). Do not use Bugaboo Donkey³ parts or components with any non-approved stroller or any other Bugaboo product.
- 36. The Bugaboo Fox² frame (no. 230587 or 230589) should only be used with the Bugaboo Fox² chassis (no. 234331 or 234341). Do not use Bugaboo Fox² parts or components with any non-approved stroller or any other Bugaboo product.

- 37. The Bugaboo Ant seat hardware (no. 914250) should only be used with the Bugaboo Ant chassis (no. 914130 or 914140). Do not use Bugaboo Ant parts or components with any non-approved stroller or any other Bugaboo product.
- 38. The Bugaboo Lynx frame (no. 230852AL01 or no.230852ZW01) should only be used with the Bugaboo Lynx chassis (no. 234810 or no. 234815). Do not use Bugaboo Lynx parts or components with any non-approved stroller or any other Bugaboo product.
- 39. Only use authentic Bugaboo replacement parts and Bugaboo accessories or products approved by Bugaboo for use with the Bugaboo stroller. It is unsafe to use products that are not approved by Bugaboo.
- 40. Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a bassinet or cradle or attach strings to toys.

- 44. It is possible that on floors such as synthetic laminates, parquet, linoleum and carpet (organic surface floors), rubber black tires may leave permanent marks. Should you have a floor as mentioned above we recommend to be careful with indoor usage.
- 45. This product is not suitable for running or skating.
- 46. WARNING: Use the wrist loop strap to stop the pram/stroller rolling away.
- 47. Ensure vehicle is correctly folded and latch engaged when lifting or carrying the vehicle.
- 48. The vehicle is designed for use on flat or gently sloping surfaces. It may be unstable on higher sloping and uneven surfaces; users should be made aware of the possibility of the vehicle tipping over.

BASSINET SPECIFIC *

- 49. Maximum weight for the child in the bassinet is 9 kg (20 lbs).
- 50. This product is only suitable for a child who cannot sit up unaided.
- 51. FALL HAZARD -To help prevent falls, do not use this product when the infant begins to push up on hands and knees or has reached 9 kg (20 lbs), whichever comes first.
- 52. Do not use the bassinet or a car seat in the two wheel position.
- 53. SUFFOCATION HAZARD Infants have suffocated:
 - In gaps between extra padding and the side of the bassinet/cradle, and
 - On soft bedding. Use ONLY the mattress, including sheet cover and aerated inlay, provided by Bugaboo for the Bugaboo stroller.

• NEVER add a pillow, comforter, or another mattress for padding.

SEAT SPECIFIC

- 54. The seat is not suitable for children under 6 months*.
- 55. FALL HAZARD Avoid serious injury from falling or sliding out. Always use the complete five point restraint system.
- 56. Never let your child stand up in the seat. Be careful because your child may stand up even when the seatbelt is fastened.
- 57. Always use the wrist strap when in two wheel position**.
- 58. WARNING: Do not use the seat facing world in the 2-wheel position. It is not an intended use position**.
- 59. Never leave the harness buckled when not fitted to a child in the pram/stroller because the harness can form loops which may pose a strangulation.
- *Not applicable to the Bugaboo Bee⁶ and Bugaboo Ant, as Bugaboo Ant and Bugaboo Bee⁶ are suitable for children from 0 to 48 months.
- ** *Not applicable to the Bugaboo Bee⁶ or Bugaboo Ant as they cannot be used in a two-wheel position.

USING BASSINET OR SEAT OFF THE CHASSIS*

- 60. Maximum weight for the child in the seat when used independently of the chassis is 9 kg (20 lbs).
- 61. Do not use the bassinet or seat off the chassis once your child can sit unaided**.
- 62. The seat does not replace a cot or bed. The seat is not intended for prolonged periods of sleeping. Should your child need to sleep then place it in a suitable cot or bed.
- 63. FALL HAZARD Child's activity can move carrier. NEVER place carrier on counter tops, tables, or any other elevated surface.
- 64. SUFFOCATION HAZARD Infant carrier can roll over on soft surfaces and suffocate child. NEVER place carrier on beds, sofas, or other soft surfaces. Only use on a firm, horizontal level and dry surface.
- 65. NEVER use this carrier as a means to transport an infant in a motor vehicle.
- * Seat off the chassis user mode is not applicable to the Bugaboo Bee⁶ or Bugaboo Ant.
- ** This user mode is not applicable to the Bugaboo Ant as it doesn't have a bassinet/carrycot.

RAIN COVER

66. SUFFOCATION HAZARD - Do not use the sun canopy in the extended position in combination with the rain cover.

- 67. During use ensure that the rain cover does not come into contact with the child's face.
- 68. Monitor your child frequently, when using the rain cover.
- 69. Do not use the rain cover for prolonged periods of time.
- 70. Do not use the rain cover outside when it is not raining and do not leave your child under the rain cover with sunny weather, due to risk of overheating.
- 71. Do not use the rain cover inside.
- 72. Do not use the rain cover with hard wind (wind force 8 and above).
- 73. In stormy weather use the sun canopy under the rain cover on the second position.
- 74. Do not use on any other product than recommended by the manufacturer.

DAMAGE

75. WARNING: Do not use the Bugaboo stroller if any part is broken, torn or missing. You should ensure that any damaged or worn parts are repaired immediately.
